## VILLAGE OF EDGERTON, OHIO SUMMARY OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Bills for Utility Services are sent on the last business day of the month. Bills are due and payable on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. If a bill for Utility Services is not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup>, a twenty (20%) percent penalty shall be added to the current charges. If the bill is not paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month a disconnect notice will be delivered to the premises at a charge of \$15.00. If the bill is not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, Utility Services may be disconnected or discontinued for non-payment and another \$15.00 charge added to the account. When the bill is paid in full, Utility Services will be reactivated with a reconnection fee of \$15.00 added to the account.
- The Village shall have the right at all times to enter any residence or place of business in order to read, install or remove its meters. Any recipient of Utility Services agrees to pay a minimum or fixed rate as determined by the Village whether or not any Utility Services have been used during the period.
- If any applicant for Utility Services is not the owner of the premises for which the request for services is made, such owner shall be required to guarantee payment for Utility Services provided to the applicant, or in lieu thereof, the applicant may deposit with the Utility Clerk a utility deposit.
- Application for Utility Services may not be made by anyone other than the actual occupant of the premises for which service is sought, or by the owner of such premises.
- All residential recipients of Utility Services shall use the garbage and recycle services. Applicants shall not permit any person who is not a resident of the premises to place refuse or garbage at such residence for pick-up. **CUSTOMERS WILL BE HELD LIABLE FOR GARBAGE BROUGHT INTO THE VILLAGE BY UNAUTHORIZED INDIVIDUALS.** Garbage shall be placed in suitable containers with handles, garbage bags, and or boxes. Tires, batteries, brush, fencing, large appliances, used oil or other hazardous materials are not to be placed outside for pick-up. The Village provides for Spring and Fall pickup, and disposal of excess and larger items during the months of May and October. Hazardous materials are not included in Spring and Fall cleanup.
- Applicants shall pay for Utility Services at the then current rates, and agree to abide by and be bound by all rules, regulations and ordinances of the Village with respect to the provisions of Utility Services.
- At no time is used oil or other hazardous waste to be poured into the sewers.
- The Village shall not be responsible for loss or damages to person or property, regardless of fault, arising from or caused, either in whole or part, by the provision of Utility Services to applicants, or by the interruption of Utility Services. Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold the Village harmless from any loss or damage arising from the use of Utility Services.
- The Village has the right to collect any unpaid account balance. If a final balance is not paid within 30 days, the account will be subject to collection/court action for payment in full.
- As used herein, "Utility Services" shall include electric, water, sewer, garbage and recycling services provided to the applicant by the Village.
